DIRECTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Please read carefully the examination regulations printed below:

- (a) Any candidate who fails to put down correctly his/her full **Index Number** will have his/her paper cancelled.
- (b) Candidates will be permitted into the examination room with their own battery operated cordless noiseless pocket-size calculators without print-out or memory capacities.
- (c) The examination regulations PROHIBIT a student from:

The Supervisor is empowered to discontinue the examination of a candidate suspected of misconduct and to require him/her to leave the examination room. Any student who fails to comply with the above regulations may be liable for such penalties as the Institute may determine.
